The PAC would like to invite you to an important meeting with the members of the CSF (French School Board) regarding the construction of our new school planned by the City of Vancouver on the Heather Lands site. It is important to understand that the construction of this school will also have a major impact on Jules-Verne.

CSF members will be attending and will answer your questions.

Your support is extremely important as we need the Ministry of Education to speed up the process for the construction of our new French-language school, as provided for by the Supreme Court order. If there is no announcement very soon, we, as parents, will have to rely on the law to protect our rights once again.

The Supreme Court's decision must be implemented.
